Regulation issued by the Curricular Commission for Informatics concerning the definition of the first and second component of the Master's thesis to be completed as part of the Master's degrees in Informatics 19W, Applied Informatics 13W and Artificial Intelligence and Cybersecurity 20W

On the basis of Section 18 (7a, ultimate sentence) of Part B of the University Statutes, the following is hereby decreed:

Section 1 Components to be completed

- (1) The first component of the Master's thesis comprises an exposé of the planned thesis including motivation, research question, methodology, research design, and a literature review. It is completed by means of an introductory presentation held in the context of the research seminar along with the submission of an exposé with a length of at least 1000 words.
- (2) The second component of the Master's thesis comprises the completion and documentation of a substantial part (e.g. the theoretical-conceptual or practical part) of the thesis and shall be delivered by means of submitting the corresponding, largely completed chapters of the Master's thesis.

Section 2 Entry into force

This regulation will enter into force on the day following its publication in the university bulletin of the University of Klagenfurt.
